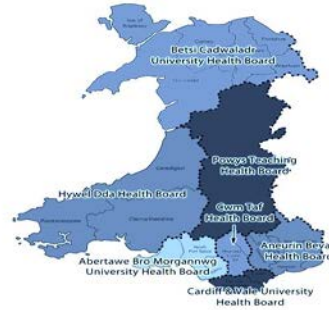

Making Decisions on Individual Patient Funding Requests (IPFR)



- Launched in October 2016
- Developed to implement recommendations 2,3,8 and 9 of the 2014 IPFR review
- Additional features included to support the IPFR administration process

General overview

- Developed and maintained by NHS Wales Information Services (NWIS)



- Deployed across the NHS Wales intranet
- Level of access depends upon requirements of the user, requested by the IPFR co-ordinator for each panel

Recommendation 2

- To collate emerging trends / identify cohorts
- Compiling annual report
- Monitoring applications



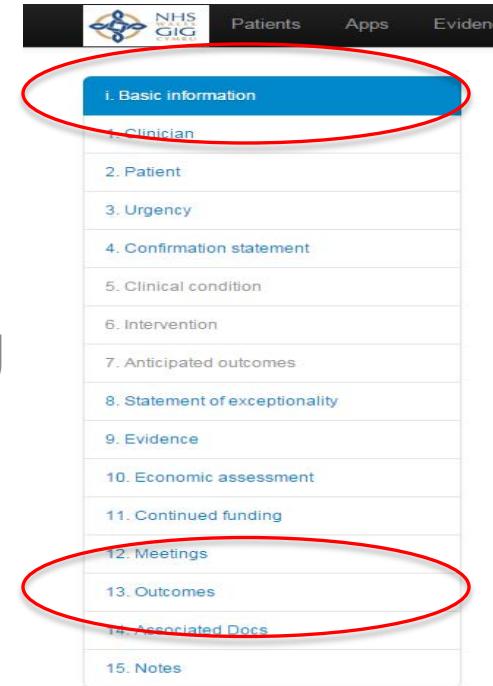
Recommendation 3

- Create a searchable central data store for evidence



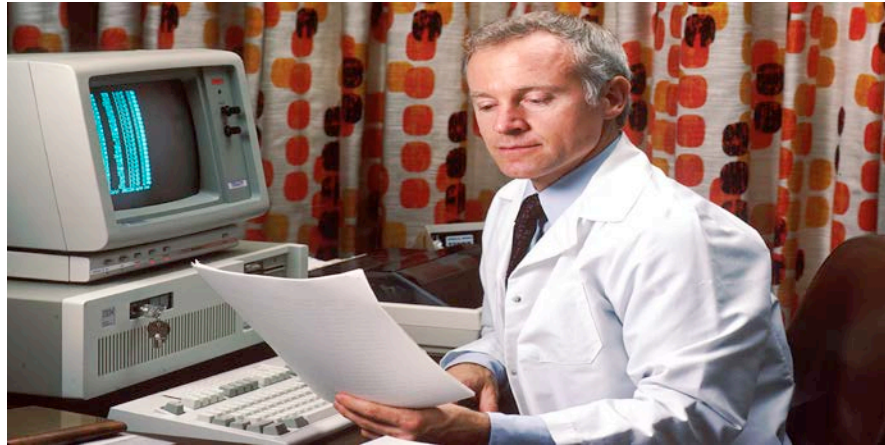
Recommendations 8 and 9
